The Mid-Atlantic Chinese Shar-Pei Rescue Operation (MACSPRO) is a privately funded 501(c)3 non-profit organization dedicated to the rehabilitation and adoption of purebred Chinese Shar-Pei. MACSPRO relies **solely** on donations and fund raising activities in order to raise income to be able to help save these wonderful Shar-Pei who, through no fault of their own, need new forever homes. Your entire donation is used for the benefit of the dogs and may be tax deductible. In addition to donations, we are continuously in need of committed volunteers who can help foster, transport and socialize with our dogs until they are able to be matched with their forever home.

**RESCUES & ADOPTIONS since January, 2013.** Below is an updated list of rescues and adoptions since our last newsletter in January, 2013. **Those listed with an asterisk (\*) next to them are available for adoption**. All of our dogs are spayed or neutered prior to adoption (health/age permitting); have been heartworm tested; parasite tested and had all necessary shots. Injuries or other health conditions have been treated and any known health issues will be fully disclosed prior to adoption/fostering.

**China\*** is our kennel dog at Debendale. She is quite special, and loves her treats and special care from Marge and Kim. She would really love a home for her remaining years.

**Andie 445-12** is a great Pei. He loves people, but not so dog friendly. He was adopted by his foster mom Lynn.

**Gandhi 450-12** is a young Pei/hound mix full of play and kisses. He found his furever home in Frederick with other friends and their parents that love to socialize together with their dogs and play in the dog park.

**Budha 471-13** came in from Howard County and barely a week later was on his way to his new life in Baltimore, MD with previous MACSPRO adopter Steven.

**Nelly 472-13** had less than 24 hours in Manhattan, NY shelter. Cindy drove all the way up to save her. She was found to have a Mass Cell tumor on her check which has been removed and she is recuperating with the Figgatts and their Pei Freckles in Woodsboro, MD.

**Pebbles\* 473-12** was also on death row in Manhattan. We got her transported down to the Aberdeen MD area where Cindy picked her up. She is a gentle shy girl that will blossom with some TLC and good food. She developed Kennel Cough in the Manhattan Shelter and had serious entropic issues.

**Bella\* 474-13** is a beautiful crème Pei. She comes from Chambersburg, PA. Her family had to move and were not permitted animals in their new home. She is completely house trained, walks well on leash. She is an easy keeper.

**Walton\* 475-13** from Princeton, WVa is heartworm positive, and will need a quiet environment to recuperate from his treatments. He is very quiet in the car and friendly. Won't you consider giving him a warm comfortable home?

**Sampson 477-13** is a 3 month old black meat mouth puppy that incurred some injury to his tummy. It looks like he got into something. He was quickly fostered by the Cardenas family in Waldorf.



#### DO YOU SHOP ONLINE?

#### Join iGive.com to support MACSPRO.

**iGive** is a free service to causes and members. **iGive** really is as simple as it sounds. **iGive** members can generate donations by shopping at any of their 1,000+ stores. There are no costs, obligations, nor any hidden fees.

**SHOPPING**: It's all automatic! You don't need to enter any codes, notify the store, or iGive. When iGive members shop via our special links (starting at the iGive.com web site, the iGive Newsletter, or having installed the iGive Button), tracking enables iGive to identify the purchases of each individual iGive member with a member ID number. Causes always receive 100% of the donation amount which is advertised on our web site (iGive.com receives fees separately from the amounts that go to the cause).

When you do start with iGive, stores automatically send the needed information (order amount, order date, and your ID number which identifies the user to iGive.com but is meaningless to the online store) so that iGive can track the donation to each member's designated cause. When you successfully link to an iGive store, your visit will be immediately visible in the You recently visited box. You can create your own list of favorite stores under My Stores. After being reported to iGive, your transactions can be reviewed in your shopping report under Stats. It can take up to 30 days after they've shipped (or travel has commenced) for purchases to get posted to your report, although the average is about 10 days. In-store exchanges may void donations. Please review any posted store exceptions.

# **ADD A MICROCHIP**

A microchip is the single best way to ensure that your pet will make its way back to you in case he runs off, or gets lost.

Visit your vet regularly and make sure your pets are up to date on all of their immunizations

# Ear Infections

If your dog suffers from an ear infection, hold your pet's head to the side and use an ear dropper to place eight to ten drops of white Vinegar in your pet's ear. Hold your pet's head to the side for a few minutes, massaging the area around the ear, and then drain out the Vinegar. Repeat for three days. If the infection persists, take your pet to the veterinarian.\*
